## **Cleaning filters**

- 1. After each wash check the filters for residue.
- 2. Turn the coarse filter anticlockwise ① and remove the filter system ②.
- 3. Pull down the micro filter to remove.
- 4. Press the locking catches ① together and lift the coarse filter out ②.
- 5. Clean the filter elements under running water.
- 6. Re-assemble the filter system.
- Insert the filter system into the appliance and turn the coarse filter clockwise. Make sure that the arrow markings match up.


